- All students must have at least 12 credits at Maranatha Baptist University in the previous 5 years to be considered for graduation.
- As a student, you are responsible to see that you fulfill all the requirements for your academic program.
- One half of the major must be completed at Maranatha Baptist University.
- Students seeking a bachelor degree must earn a minimum of 30 credits from Maranatha Baptist University.
- Students seeking an associate degree must earn a minimum of 15 credits from Maranatha Baptist University.
- All grades must be a C- or above to apply toward any major, track, proficiency, minor or concentration, as well as English Composition 1 and 2.
- Students seeking an associate degree must complete 6 of the last 12 credits at Maranatha Baptist University.
- A minimum of 128 semester hours and 2.0 cumulative grade point average are required for graduation.
