Summary

B. Snarly symbolizes Maranatha Baptist University and the MBU family spirit. His purpose is to enhance the tradition of the institution, to encourage the student-athletes, to inspire the student body and to promote good sportsmanship for all spectators. As part of the B. Snarly Squad, you will be expected to work either in the suit as B. Snarly or to fulfill the responsibility of the spotter. The employee must be able to work nights and Saturdays, though not every night or every Saturday. Hours are varied based on events and the number of individuals on the squad. The busiest season is winter where duties may require multiple evenings each week and Saturday.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Perform as the mascot or spotter at assigned indoor or outdoor athletic events.
- Perform at other university or community functions as assigned by the Assistant Director of Athletics
- Follow all procedures and safety guidelines as outlined in the B. Snarly Squad handbook
- Maintain healthy eating and hydration habits
- Represent the institution with correct behavior both in and out of costume.
- Be an example of good sportsmanship both in and out of costume.
- Communicate with the mascot and keep the mascot safe while working as a spotter
- Keep B. Snarly's moves, mannerisms and personality consistent

Qualifications Requirements

- Height recommendation is between 5'5" and 6'1"
- Display character traits of enthusiasm, creativity, and spontaneity
- Physically capable of performing required movements and activities
- Ability to positively interact well with children
- Display character qualities of self-discipline and responsibility
- Approved through a Student Life and Academic Extra-curricular eligibility check



- Good academic and social standing required
- Health and vehicle insurance

Physical Demands

- Heavy physical exertion because of high temperatures
- Maneuvering with limited visibility due to the B. Snarly suit
- Frequent standing, walking, jumping and hand shaking
- Occasional sitting
- Moderately high stress level

Work Environment

- Conditions of limited visibility due to the B. Snarly suit
- Conditions of hot temperatures inside the suit
