How much does the program cost?

You can find tuition and fee listings <u>HERE</u> under Finances. Payment for each session is due one week before class begins.

Are there any scholarships available?

Yes! You can apply for the <u>Teaching & Leading Scholarship</u>, available to those in full-time Christian ministry – including homeschooling parents.

What financial aid is available?

What is a guest student?

A guest student is one who has been approved to take credits without fully enrolling in the program.

When can I start?

What if I started a program somewhere else?

Send us your transcripts along with your application. We allow up to 6 credits to be transferred if they match the course descriptions for our courses.

Does this graduate program lead to accreditation, certification or licensing?

If you are pursuing a certification or endorsement through a state or alternative accrediting agency (such as AACS or ACSI), please contact that organization to verify that this program meets the specified requirements.
