

Psalm 139

Psalm 139 divides into three sections as David declares truth, meditates on truth, and then applies truth. His closing prayer and opening statement frame the entire psalm. God's intimate and complete knowledge of David led him to humbly ask to reveal sin because David knew how God treated the wicked.

139:1 "O LORD, thou hast **searched me**, and **known me...**"

Message

*Humbly trust
God because
He knows
everything
about you.*

139:1–6 | **Declaration** (God Knows)

David rehearses truths about God.

Truth: God personally and thoroughly knows you.

139:7–18 | **Meditation** (God Cares)

David considers the implications of the truths he just declared about God.

Truth: God personally cares and provides for you.

139:19–24 | **Petition** (God Hears)

David requests that God deal with him differently than the wicked.

Truth: Ask God to help you pursue him.

139:23–24 "**Search me**, O God, and **know** my heart..."
